

# HENLEY IN ARDEN CHARITIES

## The Johnson Houses

NOTICE is hereby given that a vacancy exists for an almsperson or almspersons of this Charity.

*Preference in appointment is given to persons residing in Henley, but in special cases to be approved by the Charity Commissioners this qualification may be set aside.*

The following classes of person are eligible for appointment:-

- (a) Married Couples residing in Henley, who were, or one of whom was born in Henley, failing these
- (b) Widows, Widowers or Single Persons residing in Henley, who were, born in Henley, failing these
- (c) Persons in classes (a) and (b) who were born in Henley, but are not now residing there, as mentioned above: failing these
- (d) Widows, Widowers or Single Persons who, though not born in Henley, have resided there for five years prior to the date of their application.

Almspersons are required to contribute a weekly sum towards the maintenance of the Almshouses and the services provided.
