Clifford Chambers & Milcote Neighbourhood Development Plan Referendum

The Clifford Chambers & Milcote Neighbourhood Plan was independently examined between May and September 2020 and the Examiner recommended that, subject to some proposed modifications, the Plan should proceed to referendum.

The District Council agrees with the Examiner's report and the Portfolio Holder for 'Place' at the District Council has endorsed the recommendation to proceed to referendum. The referendum will be asking whether the community wish to see the District Council use the Neighbourhood Plan to decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area (which is based on the Parish boundary).

In accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning (Referendum) Regulations 2012 (as amended) the Local Planning Authority must publicise the referendum for a minimum of 28 working days prior to the date of the referendum.

The referendum for the Clifford Chambers & Milcote Neighbourhood Plan will be held on Thursday 6 May 2021. The polling station will be The Jubilee Hall, Clifford Chambers, CV37 8HR.

A number of documents (referred to as 'specified documents' in the Regulations) have been produced in order to help you make a decision on how to vote. These specified documents can be viewed on the District Council's website at www.stratford.gov.uk/ccandmnp.
