Long Itchington Neighbourhood Development Plan Referendum

The Long Itchington Neighbourhood Plan was independently examined between September 2021 and May 2022 and the Examiner recommended that, subject to some proposed modifications, the Plan should proceed to referendum.

The District Council agrees with the Examiner's report and the Portfolio Holder for 'Place' at the District Council has endorsed the recommendation to proceed to referendum. The referendum will be asking whether the community wish to see the District Council use the Neighbourhood Plan to decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area (which is based on the Parish boundary).

In accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning (Referendum) Regulations 2012 (as amended) the Local Planning Authority must publicise the referendum for a minimum of 28 working days prior to the date of the referendum.

The referendum for the Long Itchington Neighbourhood Plan will be held on Thursday 2 March 2023.

The polling stations will be:

- Holy Trinity Church, Church Road, Long Itchington CV47 9PG
- Long Itchington Community Centre, Stockton Road, Long Itchington CV47 9QP

A number of documents (referred to as 'specified documents' in the Regulations) have been produced in order to help you make a decision on how to vote. These specified documents can be viewed on the District Council's website at **www.stratford.gov.uk/linp**

Alternatively, printed versions of the specified documents are available to view at Stratford-on-Avon District Council's offices, Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford-upon-Avon, and Stratford-upon-Avon Library and Southam Library during normal opening hours.
